5	Proposals were the remit of another service/fund or organisation
6	Organisation was ineligible
7	Inclusion of inappropriate costs (e.g., equipment only requests)
8	Organisation did not demonstrate the beneficiaries could not fund the activity themselves
9	There were concerns about group governance and/or financial diligence
10	There was insufficient evidence about how City residents in greatest need would be targeted to benefit from Council funds
11	The organisation had high reserves and did not explain why those reserves could not be used to fund the activity
12	The group did not explain how they would measure impact and/or the intended impact was unclear
