Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Deputy Returning Officer at Customer Services Reception, Mandela House, 4 Regent Street, Cambridge CB2 1BY on any working day after the date of this notice, Monday to Friday 9:30 am to 5 pm, but no later than 4 pm on Wednesday 2 April 2025. Please make an appointment [online](#) or telephone 01223 457048 if you do not have online access.
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 1 May 2025** between the hours of 7 am and 10 pm.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 11:59 pm on Friday 11 April 2025. Applications can be made online at gov.uk/register-to-vote.
7. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate (free voter ID) or Anonymous Elector's Document must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday 23 April 2025. Applications can be made online at gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
8. New applications to vote by post or the amendment or cancellation of an existing postal vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Monday 14 April 2025. Postal vote applications can be made online at gov.uk/apply-postal-vote.
9. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday 23 April 2025. Amendments or cancellations to existing proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Monday 14 April 2025. Proxy applications can be made online at gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote.
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Thursday 1 May 2025.
